Camping Information Sheet

Welcome to the sixth El Sueño Existe Festival. We hope that you have a very enjoyable weekend with us in Machynlleth.

To ensure that everyone on the campsite has a comfortable stay, we would appreciate it if you could read this information sheet.

It is important to remember that this is not an official camping site and therefore we have had to make some rules regarding the use of the site, in order to make it work for everyone concerned.

- Campers must show their tent or campervan ticket at the campsite reception/entrance. If you don't yet have one, please go round to the main festival site to the ticket desk. You will then need to affix it to your tent/campervan
- **Campers should arrive at the site no later than 10.30pm**
- Camper vans and cars are not allowed onto the playing field, by order of the school, but should park in the school car park.
- Large camper van awnings may not be permitted due to the limited space available, and this decision will be at the discretion of the Campsite Supervisor. We trust that people will respect this decision.
- **□** The building of campfires on the site is strictly forbidden by the school authorities.
- Please do not take used disposable bbq's inside tent spaces for personal safety reasons they can emit gases which can kill.
- Please respect other campers by not making any undue noise, especially late at night. Campers causing a disturbance may be asked to leave the site. There will be a QUIET ZONE area for people wanting to go to sleep early and we ask campers to respect this.
- □ Individuals are responsible for the security of their own belongings and the festival organisers do not take any responsibility for anything left on-site, unattended.
- There should be a festival representative on the camp-site all of the time to answer any questions you may have, and a security officer will be on duty during the night.

- □ The camp-site needs to be vacated by 5pm on Sunday.
- □ There will be rubbish bags provided to each camping party. <u>We kindly ask that you take these</u> bags with you at the end of the festival.
- There are some recycling facilities in the car park at the school. There is also recycling in the main pay-and-display carpark.
- □ Please keep the camp-site tidy and do not leave empty bottles and cans lying around

There is also a 'boys' toilet in the car park. This is for El Sueno campers only, and we have decided to make it unisex (read the note on the toilet door)

The school showers and toilets will be available during the day -

Friday till 8pm Saturday from 8am to 8pm Sunday from 9am to 1pm.

Please help keep the shower and toilet areas clean after use.

There is an outdoor tap for drinking water located on the lower car park next to the school entrance to the showers.

LEISURE CENTRE:

There are shower facilities at the Leisure Centre, adjacent to the Festival Site that you can pay to use –

Special Offer for campsite users -

£1.50 shower (normally £1.80) on showing El Sueño wristband to the Staff. Open 7:30 am till 4pm each day

They will also be doing a free shower if you spend £5 in their Café. Ask the Leisure Centre Desk for details.

Supermarkets: There is a small Spar supermarket with Post Office half-way up the High Street on the left hand side, and a large Co-op is further up on the right hand side. There is also Harry Tuffins supermarket in the garage opposite the railway station.
